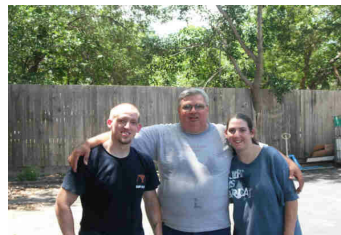

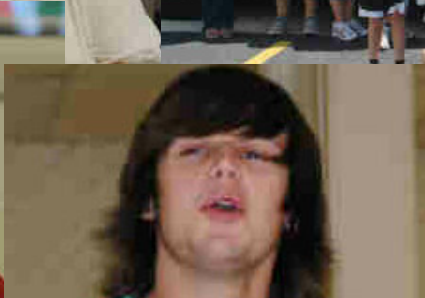

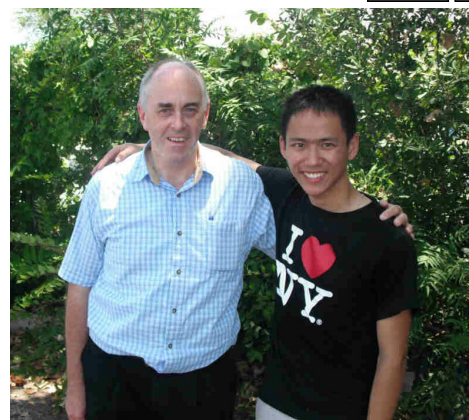

WORDS OF ENCOURAGEMENT FROM A WORKER IN THE HARVEST FIELDS

Thank you for always trying to fill our order of printed material we request. We use them every day for World Bible School students the world over.

When Prissy Sellers and I started going to Tombolombo, Malawi, we did not have a single tract of any kind to hand out. So the second year we went, we sent over hundreds of Mission Printing material weeks before we left. They were there when we arrived. When we went into the villages, people literally begged for more because they had never seen anything like these.

As we went into the Mzimba prison to work with inmates, we carried hundreds of Mission Printing studies for the prisoners. Many of these were put in the prison library for the prisoners

and guards to come in and read. We also put your songbooks in the prison library, and they are used for worship for the over 300 who have been baptized and worship each Lord's day at this prison. They then go back to the library until the next worship day.

We have a full-time preacher who works with this prison and for the prisoners when they are released to help them get back with family and the outside world again. One prisoner was released while we were there last year, and he is now working full-time with one of the village congregations. They need tracts on the church and worship and many other things.

Thank you for the great work you do for the Lord.

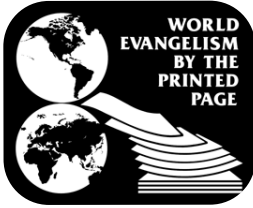
